

### CAN YOU PROVIDE A FRIENDLY & SUPPORTIVE HOME ENVIRONMENT FOR A YOUNG CIVIL SOCIETY LEADER FROM EAST INDONESIA – FOR 6 MONTHS?

We are looking for hosts for 8 young Indonesian community-based leaders who will be in Auckland from late June to mid-December 2018. Aged between 20 and 35 years, they will be participating in INSPIRASI (the Indonesian Young Leaders Programme), a UnionAID, AUT University and BaKTI (East Indonesia) partnership. The participants will be from the provinces of East Indonesia, and work with civil society organisations (e.g. environmental, trade union, women's and human rights organisations).

For host families this is a chance to learn about Indonesia, support the young leaders in their discoveries, and participate (if you have time) in social activities. Hosts are paid for their guest's room and board.

Participants will have reasonable English language skills on arrival. Their programme includes:

- ◆ 2-week orientation to Auckland and AUT
- ◆ 12-week intensive English language improvement course
- ◆ 11-week programme to further develop knowledge, skills and confidence as leaders in the sustainable development of their communities and the wider East Indonesia region.

The Programme is fully funded by the NZ Ministry of Foreign Affairs & Trade. Participants do not pay for travel or course fees. UnionAID has run a similar programme for Myanmar Young Leaders in Wellington for several years – so we have plenty of experience in selecting and supporting both participants and host families.
